Do not re-enter the building until the 'all clear' is provided by emergency responders and/or building fire wardens.

Emergency Evacuation and Response

In an emergency call **911** from a mobile or **9-911** from a campus phone

Description of this Location: **Health Science Building, 107 Wiggins Road**

Evacuating from this Location: D-Wing, Ground Floor, North Elevator

From the elevator turn around and go through the door toward the north exit. Evacuate the building and proceed to the **Marshalling Area** at/near the Gordon Oaks Red Bear Student Centre

Assembling Point

1. Organizing the line in which students are to form from leaving their seats to exit and others.
2. Call 911 (or 9-911) to report all emergency conditions. Informative. Advise a representative notified of all emergency exit with instructions from all students and staff to evacuate. Do not proceed to campus.
3. Evacuate and avoid using elevators unless you are going to a higher floor or avoiding a dangerous situation.

Secure Weather Lockdown

1. Secure doors of all rooms located in the building.
2. Secure weather lockdown and work with students in the classroom.
3. Inform students about evacuation. When students evacuate to campus, they should be instructed to go to the Marshalling Area.
4. Call 909-880-0000 to report severe weather.
5. Check for other class emergencies.
